TVO Responsibilities

- Produce and make available the ILC courses
- Validate and assess students for program placement
- Mark the assignments and final tests
- Approve the recommended Facilitators
- Approve the recommended test supervisors for the final tests
- Grant course credits & Grant Ontario Secondary School Diplomas

SCI Responsibilities

- Select and approve the foreign schools as sub-licensees
- Establish English language competency eligibility criteria for the students
- Review student academic documentations
- Review qualifications of Facilitators and forward to TVO for approval
- Collect payments from the schools/students for assessment and ILC Courses
- Employ test supervisors to supervise the final tests
- Support and oversee the foreign schools

School Responsibilities

- Recruit and enroll students in the ILC program
- Provide a class room with computers for students to receive guidance from facilitators
- Designate qualified Facilitators to assist students with course selection and progress
- Schools can provide extra ESL and tutoring outside of the ILC program
- Test English language competency of the students

Academic Bond

- Each school will be required to place CAD\$5,000 bond in escrow account
- Repayable within 60 days following the end of the term

English Language Assessment

TVO ILC Grade 9 & 10 Program Admission – IELTS 4.5-5.0; or TOEFL 40-60; and TVO ILC Grade 11 & 12 Program Admission – IELTS 5.0-5.5; or TOEFL 50-70.

PLAR Assessment

Provide translated and notarized transcripts and all available information to determine Student eligibility and assessment for program placement.

Tuition Fees

- School shall pay CAD\$750/course Net to SCI.
- Uniform price and margin for schools will be set by SCI annually in consultation with partner schools. The maximum will be CAD\$2,000
- Initial Assessment Fee: Maximum CAD\$300 (\$200 to SCI-TVO)
